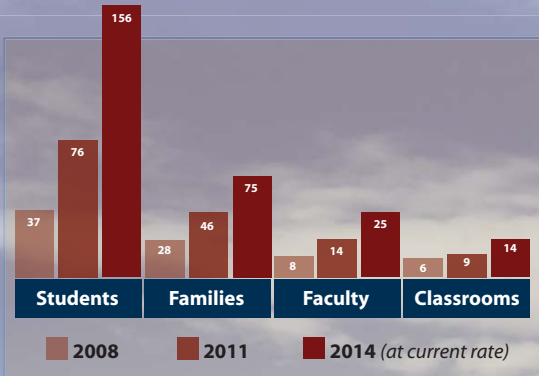

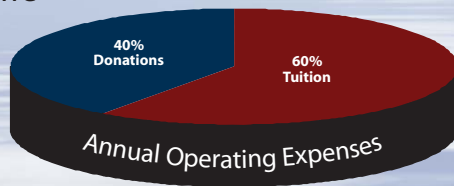
financial situation, to give their children a Chelsea education.
